Making the right connections

One area that causes considerable anxiety for many new and existing selfbuilders is that of coordinating the supply and delivery of new utility services.

Even if you're only looking to build a single dwelling, coordinating service provisions could mean liaising with upwards of 10 separate parties over many months. The requirements and complexity for blocks of flats or a series of properties could be even greater. In addition to dealing with local councils and regulatory authorities you'll also have to select which suppliers to go with for gas, electricity, water and communications from all those available – but which will deliver the package you require?

Each project will be quite different and while many of the suggestions listed below for managing the new connection process appear to be quite logical, they are regularly overlooked. So to avoid some of the more common pitfalls you should:

- Carefully plan the provision of all utilities at the outset of the project and start negotiations as soon as possible – 6 - 9 months in advance should be the minimum time frame to consider
- Don't under estimate the amount of time that will be needed to manage the process – then at least double it and you may be getting close
- Factor in appropriate housing to accommodate the supplies and metering and consider the ducting that will be required to reach them
- Don't ignore what is currently on-site as you may need to remove or re-route them to get the new supplies to the new point in the property where they will be connected
- If you require temporary supplies during the build, consider putting the site amenities close to the eventual termination

point, constantly moving things around can be costly

- It's a highly competitive market so complete your market test and don't simply select a supplier purely on the fact they were the only one contacted to provide a proposal
- Independent Connection Providers (ICPs) for electricity and Utility Infrastructure Providers (UIPs) for gas are able provide the initial connections through to installing the metering so you don't have to use the 'traditional' Distribution Network Operators in the area
- Think about future requirements and allow for them in the plan. Fibre is the perfect example here – you may not need it now but it is clearly looking like the future for all types of entertainment and communications – so get proposals up front.

If this all appears just a little too complicated or daunting, help is at hand. Over recent years and with the de-regulation of the sector, specialist players with expert knowledge, advice and experience have emerged and are taking the sector by storm. They can take on the coordination of the process, saving many selfbuilders time, money and heartache.

"Many people seriously under estimate the time and effort needed to coordinate the delivery of new utility services," stated Jeff Wilson a connection project manager at Sutton based **Maxim Eyes**, one such company that has steadily grown over recent years, by providing professional project management services for new utility connections. "By coordinating all the new provisions on a project we ensure that everything is cost effectively delivered on time and our clients gain real economies of scale."

Top kitchen trends for 2013

The kitchen is now heralded as the social hub of the house. Makeover experts **Granite Transformations** look at the hottest design trends for 2013, which enable the kitchen to take on an exciting new look without breaking the bank.

#1 Kitchen remodelling

The hottest trend is remodelling, which involves retaining the familiar layout and cabinetry, but refacing existing worktops and cabinet doors and drawers.

#2 Colourful kitchens

Vibrant colours like red, orange and emerald green are popular for worktops, reflecting a more casual, upbeat way of living, or high gloss door facings in olive, paprika, blueberry or plum.

#3 Mixed finishes

Take a cue from interior designers, with a mix of cabinetry finishes that combine dark and lighter tones at different levels. Or perhaps choose a different worktop colour for an island, to contrast with main cabinets.

#4 Bolder splashbacks

#5 Cleaner lines

#6 Island units

If space allows, an island unit turns your layout into a designer kitchen, with bar stools for informal dining and conversation. Centre islands can feature fashionable waterfall ends, bringing worktops almost to ground level, or curved doors for a more fluid, ergonomic feel.

#7 Eco-chic materials

Eco-friendly materials are still gaining popularity. Choose from recycled glass worktops or composite granite and quartz surfaces containing natural stone salvaged from quarrying sites.

#8 Decorative murals

It can be effective to introduce a bold splash of colour with a wall mural or feature panel. Authentic glass mosaic tiles mounted on a backing mattress introduce colour, texture and a tactile finish, while natural daylight and halogen spotlights contribute a reflective dimension.

A chip off the old block

The Smiths had always wanted a traditional, but modern, Georgian house fit for a king.

And now they have one, throne included

The Georgian period in architecture was typified by a fascination with basic symmetry

The Georgian period in architecture was typified by a fascination with basic symmetry and centred, large panel-fronted doors, topped with rectangular windows. The elegant lines and functional simplicity of Georgian design meant that even after 1840, Georgian-style or neo-Georgian houses never really went out of fashion and, to this day, it remains the style of choice for high-end homes on many a modern estate.

A true Georgian-style manor house also requires the accompaniment of extensive grounds. However, with a gravel drive and a well-manicured lawn to complement the Palladian splendour of the house itself, the

acquisition of extensive acreage of parkland in rural East Sussex was a perfect beginning from which Jack and Debbie Smith could embark on their own Georgian self build.

The Smiths began their build in 2008 and completed it in 2012. They used traditional methods and reclaimed materials for much of the build. "We've always had big houses as we've always liked the space – the light and the high ceilings – so, we knew what we wanted," Debbie said. "You don't see traditionally-built houses any more; very few people do it."

Some of the traditional details of the interiors, are so subtle that they would go almost

unnoticed, making the house elegant. For example, the high skirting boards. In comparison to the traditional Georgian method of construction, there are some differences with this build, as Jack explained: "The main structure would have been slightly different because they wouldn't have had insulation blocks – or insulation full stop – available to them as we have now. This house is very well insulated, but that's something we had to do."

Building regulations caused some problems with the installation of the windows.

"We wanted big windows, high windows, and with all the regulations now, things like that

are really difficult. It's very easy to do an eco-friendly house and have little tiny windows, because you're not losing any heat. But because we wanted these great big windows, we've had to really step up everything else to get that low U-value," explained Debbie.

"We also have 'pocket doors' that we copied from a Georgian house, after being so impressed with them. They slide into the wall, so that you can leave them open as far as you want without the problem of them slamming in the breeze."

The house itself has a typically white painted, Georgian exterior but it is filled with many modern, additional features. The basement is comprised of five rooms, one of which is the swimming pool.

"It is chemical-free so that the odour of chlorine doesn't permeate the house, which is what usually happens with indoor pools," said Debbie. "We have an ioniser, which uses copper and silver to purify the water continuously so that it is always safe to drink, and because it has no chemicals or salt in, it is kind to hair and skin."

"We also have all the water that enters the house ionised because it stops bacteria breeding in the showerheads and other areas where water might lie. It's considered to be beneficial

to health because of its antibacterial properties.

"The man who pioneered this system has installed it all over the world in public fountains, to counteract the spread of Legionnaires Disease," Debbie continued. "And also to purify dirty water to make it safe to drink in poorer countries. His name is Noel Parkinson and he lived locally in Waldron though he sadly passed away recently."

The four basement rooms – aside from the pool – consist of a sauna or steam room, a pool/snooker room, a gym and a cinema – but all of these are secondary to Debbie's favourite feature: the Quooka boiling tap, which means there is no need for a kettle. Apart from the many fun gadgets and rooms solely invented for procrastination, the Smiths have also installed a very practical feature, which differs from many ordinary builds – underfloor heating throughout.

"Underfloor heating is probably the star of this house. It's in every room, on all four floors and in the garage," said Jack. "I like to keep my car warm!"

The heating is powered by a ground source heat pump, which was troublesome to install.

"We had to start from scratch with that. If we'd have left it later, I don't think we would have done it. We put 3,000 metres of pipe one metre below ground, so that was a lot of

engineering work."

The garden had to be dug up prior the installation of the heat pump and re-laid afterwards. The Smiths did this first, as a garden needs time to grow and develop. For the installation of the pump, 15 separate trenches had to be dug, each one 50 metres long and a metre deep.

The ground source heat pump is very important for the Smiths' energy saving, as Jack explained: "For every kilowatt that we put in or that we pay for (because you use electricity to run the pumps), we get the equivalent of four kilowatts of heat. If you consider what we're getting – the heating of the whole house, the swimming pool, all of our hot water, cooking, washing – it is worth installing a system like this."

"If someone was to go for electric central heating, without some sort of heat pump, it

would just be too expensive." Debbie added.

The Smiths also are awaiting the government's decision to include ground source heat pumps within their Feed-In tariff agreement. This would mean that not only would they generate renewable heat energy from the ground, but they would also receive a government subsidy for the running-cost.

"We didn't go into it because of that, we didn't even know about it at the time," Debbie said. "Because this is such a big house, we had quite a high quota of renewable energy that we had to meet."

The Smiths' house is imposing but stylistically discrete, so it remains in keeping with the existing properties in the immediate neighbourhood.

"It's perhaps a bit grander than some of the other houses in the area," Debbie observed.

"There are quite a lot of different styles around here. But the house next door is very similar, and in the village there are many Georgian and Georgian-style houses, so it's not that out of character."

The Smiths built their house at a leisurely pace, Debbie explained: "The main structure was built quite quickly. We didn't want to rush it. We wanted to think about things and we weren't in a desperate hurry to move in."

The couple lived in a bungalow in a nearby

town for a year until the garage was built and they could move into a two-bed apartment above, which enabled them to keep an eye on the project on-site.

"While we were above the garage we did the garden," Debbie continued.

"It seems that everybody wants an en-suite bathroom these days," Jack said. "Every bedroom has a dressing room and a bathroom. As a result, there is no communal bathroom in the house."

The toilet seat in the ground floor cloakroom

cost the Smiths £500 due to its throne-like styling and was hand-crafted by an 80-year old joiner. Its quirky shape may have pushed up the price but made it fit for a king! With such a splendid canvas on which to paint, the temptation to ostentatious embellishment, like that in the 'throne-room', was always going to be strong, but the Smiths managed to resist all but the cloakroom and the Graeco-Roman statuary in the grounds and around the periphery of the swimming pool.

The Smiths' self build did not have any significant low points, aside from the overspend.

"As soon as you do a house of this size, everything is twice the price," Debbie exclaimed. "If you want anything a bit bigger in scale, you can't just go and get it at Jewson's," Jack said. "You have to have it made. It starts with floor beams. Because the span is so big, that doubles the price. If you want a door 3ft by 7ft, it is not on the shelf and that's what makes it so expensive."

The only other problem the Smiths came across was when they hosted a wedding and the marquee installers nearly punctured the

underground pipes used for the heat pump!

In marked contrast to the few low points, there were many highs.

"Seeing the finished result was the most amazing part of the project," Jack acknowledged.

"One of the high points was putting the bespoke staircase in," said Debbie. "We had the stairs we designed made by a stonemason. The staircase is cantilever and is only held up by the wall – but you could walk up the stairs as they were putting them in. It was something we had dreamed about, so that was a particular high."

In terms of the materials that were used in the

construction, the Smiths tried to get the best value they could.

"We found some marble tiles on the Internet, which proved to be absolutely wonderful and in the end, we used them everywhere because they are non-slip," Debbie said. "How often do you find bright shiny marble that isn't slippery, even when wet?"

Asked what advice she would give to another potential selfbuilder, Debbie said: "Get a quantity surveyor!"


This is something that the Smiths had failed to do, and it was the reason for their considerable overspend.

"We didn't cost in everything from the beginning the way that we should have," explained Jack. "We didn't really build to a budget, so the project was more expensive than it could have been. If you get a quantity surveyor, you would immediately have a better idea of how much money is likely to be involved."

Despite the fact that they exceeded their original budget, and maybe even upset the occasional neighbour, the Smiths are more than happy with how their build went and by the end-product of their labours – a modern neo-Georgian home. They would most definitely do it all again.

Breathe easy

HEAT RECOVERY VENTILATION BOX

Many selfbuilders will no doubt be asking themselves what is the right ventilation solution for their project, and many considerations must be taken into account. For example, what will the system be used for, what is an acceptable level of energy efficiency and what about aesthetics?

The past few years have seen advancements in ventilation technology, driven primarily by changes to Building Regulations and other government legislation such as the Code for Sustainable Homes (CSH), which put greater demands on air tightness in new builds.

With modern homes in the UK losing up to 25 per cent of heat due to uncontrolled ventilation and air leakage, and older properties susceptible to losing even more than that, it's little wonder why Building Regulations are becoming more stringent and ventilation is high on the checklist of considerations for selfbuilders.

There are plenty of options when it comes to ventilation, from trickle ventilation to extraction fans and mechanical ventilation with heat recovery (MVHR). However with trickle ventilators, as seen in windows, often viewed as unsightly by some, and the noise levels of extraction fans in bathrooms simply being unacceptable, a modern, more efficient means of ventilation is often required. This is where MVHR comes into the equation.

Breathing life into your home

Changes to Approved Document Part F and Part L of the Building Regulations, and the benefits attached to MVHR systems, has helped it see a surge in popularity in recent years.

For many selfbuilders, the look of their dream home plays an integral role in the overall plan-

ning and purchasing activity, however the more savvy selfbuilder is now buying into the functionality and efficiency of building materials as well as aesthetics.

MVHR is now high up on the list for any selfbuilder who wants to achieve a home that is comfortable, efficient and sustainable.


The most efficient systems are centralised whole-house MVHR systems, which incorporate supply and extract ventilation in one system. Warm air is extracted from rooms such as kitchens and bathrooms via ducting through a highly efficient counter flow heat exchanger before being exhausted to the outside. Coupled with this, fresh incoming air is preheated via the exchanger and ducted into habitable rooms.

As well as providing fresher, better quality air, the systems can recover as much as 92 per cent of heat energy, which in turn saves on the energy required for heating a home, ultimately reducing household energy bills.

A further advantage of installing a modern MVHR system in a new home is the ability to utilise the summer by-pass feature, ensuring that during warmer months only cool air is supplied into the home.

In 2010, as part of the revisions to Approved Document F of the Building Regulations, domestic ventilation became 'Notifiable Work', meaning that a suitably qualified person must carry out the work for any new ventilation system in new homes, which includes MVHR.

Installing a MVHR system should not be difficult for a qualified installer, providing that adequate planning has been done before installation. The location of a system does need to satisfy particular requirements however, such

as the system being as close as possible to an exterior wall suitable for intake and exhaust ports. Furthermore, there needs to be adequate access to a drain to accept condensed water from the unit.

It is also essential that there is a nearby source of electricity to power the internal fans, and self-builders must also consider the proximity to any existing duct that could be used to distribute fresh air throughout the house. MVHR units are extremely quiet in situ, as well as being lightweight and compact, which makes them ideal for installation in the loft of a property.

It is far easier to plan and install a system in a new build as considerations about where the ducting can go can be designed in from the outset. However, in larger refurbishment projects walls and floors are likely to be exposed down to the framework and smaller diameter, flexible radial ducts lend themselves to awkward or limited access.

Selfbuilders who design in MVHR systems can not only enjoy a highly effective ventilation solution that makes their homes fresher and more comfortable to live in, but can also look forward to energy savings thanks to the low running costs of the system – a typical MVHR system will cost between £15 - £30 pounds per year.

MVHR is one of the best ways to ensure a comfortable temperature and humidity level throughout the home, while also helping to reduce running costs. With so many benefits attached, it's easy to see why more and more selfbuilders can breathe easy when considering what ventilation system is the best for their new home.

So how does KNX work? As a simple system for intelligent electrical installation networking, a KNX bus cable combines electrical devices and systems around the home that would be part of a typical self build project. The good news is that new and additional functions or devices can be easily added at any time in the future as the homeowner's needs change and maybe extra functionality is desired.

Sensors, such as motion detectors and thermostats, send impulses over a transmission medium to actuators which then, for example, activate or deactivate the lights or can turn on/off the heating system. These sensors and actuators can be programmed and linked exactly as the selfbuilder wants. It is then easy to manipulate the functions of the KNX system using familiar switches around the home, or a tablet/telephone or even, using the internet, remotely from a computer... great if you are away for a few days.



KNX technology can regulate a home's shading, climate and lighting for each room in accordance with the outdoor temperature and prevailing daylight levels

KNX controlled products give the homeowner control over the everyday living environment. It's not just lighting and heating, although these are often the key functions because they have the most immediate impact both on lifestyle and on energy consumption. Air conditioning, security systems, the operation of blinds, the switching of electrical appliances, the opening of windows and the operation of an AV or sound system can all be integrated under KNX.

Lighting variations can be programmed to specific requirements by simply using a wall mounted touch screen. This may mean turning off or dimming lights in certain unoccupied or semi-occupied rooms or at certain times of the day to save energy. It can also include the facility to set lighting scenes – for example, in unoccupied buildings, time-controlled lights automatically open blinds to simulate occupancy. Even party mood lighting can be created!

Of course, energy management is important and power-hungry devices can be automatically switched on when electricity rates are at the lowest. Climate control is a critical area of energy conservation and automatic shading with KNX is a popular consideration. Typically, heating and lighting can be monitored and regulated so that during the winter, when warmth and light make an even greater contribution to comfort, KNX technology can regulate a home's shading, climate and lighting for each room in accordance with the outdoor tempera-

ture and prevailing daylight levels. The use of weather stations controlled by KNX can be used to control automatically the opening and closing of windows.

Another area of concern for selfbuilders is home security. Using KNX, motion detectors, glass break sensors and electronic shutter control can be connected to an alarm system or emergency call circuit. If there are suspicious noises, a panic button can be pressed and the lights go on and the shutters open. Should any alarm conditions occur, they can be conveyed by email or SMS and to a mobile phone.

In the area of assisted living, KNX can help in the execution of daily household tasks which otherwise may not be accomplished. It can interface with a property's access control system to allow the automated opening and closing of doors and the automatic illumination of certain areas at night using PIRs. The use of KNX technology can have life changing benefits.

As such a diversity of applications are covered using one standard, it means for the selfbuilder that the cabling network can be much simpler – a single twisted pair cable can often suffice, with multiple elements all operating together on a single network.

Another major advantage is that KNX installations are future proofed so that selfbuilders are not tied to one manufacturer's products – this is the result of KNX products' certified interoperability.

A typical application is that provided by KNX UK Association member Building Evolution for an Isle of Man property (pictured).

The KNX intelligent building solution for a contemporary residence demanded a versatile, intelligent home automation system with the ability to control lighting, heating, automated blinds/curtains, entrance gates, garage doors, heated towel rails and the secondary circulation of the hot water system. The adaptability of the system and the ability to add extra functionality or upgrades of KNX products at a later date were important.

Simple installation was also important. The initial installation included the control of all the property's lighting, including individual room and whole house lighting scenes.

Movement sensors have provided automatic light control on the property's landings after dark to ensure dimmed, eye-friendly lighting levels for occupants. Underfloor heating, domestic hot water and electric towel rails in all en-suite bathrooms are timed controlled from a touch panel in the kitchen.

From a security standpoint, the KNX control and monitoring of the opening and closing of gates to the property, both locally and from the remote touch panel, provide the owner with a high level of security. A touch panel in the kitchen allows the control and monitoring of the whole KNX installation from a convenient central location.

Underfloor heating – the ideal self build solution

Rob Stabbins, national sales manager, Robbens Systems, comments on how underfloor heating can be an asset to any self build

As underfloor heating (UFH) becomes an ever-more popular choice for both new build and refurbishment projects, increasing numbers of selfbuilders are realising its benefits. Not only does it offer significant energy savings and greater design flexibility than traditional heating systems (with greater heating efficiency and no radiators to plan around), it can also be tailored to the exact needs of a project. What's more, it's easier to install than many people think.

One of UFH's major benefits is that it offers an even distribution of heat – helping keep a property at an ideal temperature in an energy efficient way. While radiators heat the air directly around them, which then rises upwards before cooling as it descends, UFH uses the whole floor to radiate heat directly into the body through the feet. This eliminates the need for radiators while also delivering energy savings of up to 15 per cent. It also means rooms stay at an even, comfortable temperature of up to 3°C lower than traditional systems, as the body assimilates heat directly from the floor surface as well as the air around it.

Opting for the right system

This discreet heating efficiency makes UFH an attractive alternative to traditional radiator heating. Selfbuilders opting for an underfloor system have a choice between wet (water-based) and dry – these have different operating temperatures, which affects their suitability for various floor coverings. With this in mind, it's always best to discuss your specific requirements with your supplier, who will be able to advise on

which UFH/floor covering combination is best suited to your project.

For example, wet systems work to a lower operating temperature of between 40°C and 60°C (comparatively, radiators operate at a much higher 75°C). This flow temperature makes wet systems ideal for use alongside timber flooring, which can be prone to warping under the hotter temperatures provided by many electric UFH systems.

There are also other factors to take into account, such as the energy source. Since wet UFH typically runs from the property's boiler, rather than directly from electricity, it is also more economical to operate in the long run. Its lower flow temperatures also make it ideal for partnering with renewable heat sources, such as heat pumps or solar thermal collectors – allowing selfbuilders to benefit from even greater energy efficiency.

Tailoring to your needs

After choosing the system, the next step is ensuring the system is designed to meet the exact

specifications of the project. Without the right design, the system will not perform to its full capability. Reputable UFH suppliers will offer a full heat-loss calculation to find out exactly how much heat the property requires.

These heat-loss calculations take out the guesswork – taking into account a variety of factors to indicate how warm the floor needs to be for a comfortable room temperature, and the water temperature required from the heat source. If in doubt, talk to your supplier at quotation stage and confirm that this is the first step they will take when specifying your system.

Hassle-free installation

It's a common misconception amongst self-builders that wet UFH is difficult to fit, but it is more straightforward to install than people think. Most of the job can be done yourself, skill and

fitness level permitting. However, depending on your experience, it is a good idea to ask a professional plumber to make the final connections to the main services and an electrician to connect the electrical components at the last stages of the install.

The most important thing to remember is never to go it completely alone. Make the most of the support on offer from your UFH provider – a reputable supplier should offer expert advice and guidance from the outset of a project to its completion. For example, a supplier can use the initial heat-loss calculation to plan the system layout, showing where pipes should be laid closer together to compensate for areas of higher heat loss (e.g. by windows).

Your supplier can also advise on insulation, which is essential for optimum system performance. Insulating the floors beneath the UFH ensures

that heat travels upwards into the room rather than downwards into the ground. It ensures the system operates to maximum efficiency and that all heat is used within the property and not wasted.

A stress-free solution

As well as offering ongoing benefits, such as comfortable room temperatures and significant energy savings, with the right level of guidance wet UFH is the ideal choice for self-builders. Not only is it straightforward to install, it also integrates well with a variety of heat sources and can be designed to meet a project's exact needs. This means those working closely with a reputable supplier can focus on the long-term rather than worrying about the short-term – and concentrate on reaping the rewards of a simple, unobtrusive and efficient home heating solution.




